Subject: Against Circumcision of Children - Jews support bill 183

Dear parliament members,

I am a Jewish citizen of Israel, 32 years old. I am against circumcision in children.

My husband had a forced circumcision when he was an eight-day-old baby. We could never have sex as nature intended because he has no foreskin.

I am writing to express my strong support for bill 183 which will criminalize circumcision (genital mutilation) of underage boys and girls.

As a Jewish Israeli, I wish to let you know that there is a rapidly growing movement among Jews and among Israeli's to leave our children intact (not-circumcised).

Circumcision of a child unable to consent is genital mutilation. It is an irreversible surgery that robs the child of an important body part.

The child's right to his body is above any religious practice.

Thank you for having the courage to protect children and fight for this important bill.
